

A BRIEF HISTORY OF OUR DONATIONS

- 1995 – 1997** Contributions started in November 1995 in response to a request from the Head Mistress for 5 copies of the novel “Jazz” by *Tony Morrison*.
- Also sent audio and video tapes for the English Department, audio tapes for the Language Lab and books on Art and Music
- 1998 – 2004** We participated with the UK chapter and sent a wide assortment of science equipment, including microscopes, science models and charts, weighing and measuring equipment, human anatomy models and teacher activity binders along with an extensive array of glassware.
- 1998 - 2006** Assisted the Headmistress with the goal of revitalizing the tie as part of the school uniform. The initial supply of 500 ties was followed by yearly supplies of 350. This project ended in 2006.
- Also donated \$700 to the School’s Special Emergency Relief Fund in 2005.
- Special Reunion donation in 1999 included 10 compound microscopes, 2 Pentium processing computer units, and 2 color printers with surge protectors and cables.

- 2007 – 2008** **With a donation of \$4,300, we participated with our other alumni chapters, in a major development project for the school, the rehabilitation of the Biology Lab.**
- 2009 - 2010** **With the other chapters also, we participated in the project for the replacement of furniture for all of the classrooms. With a donation of \$3,675 we funded furniture for the entire form 4C classroom, followed by an additional \$2,000 towards another classroom.**
- We also gave 2 bursaries totaling \$500 towards the fees for 2 Science students to write the CSEC exams**
- 2011 - 2011** **We donated \$600 towards the replacement of furniture for the Language Room, and also donated \$600 towards the replacement of the hymnals , *Songs of Praise*.**
